Session 2 Counseling Session

Objective: Teachers will use this time to have one on one counseling/mentoring sessions with students in their mentoring group. Discussions may include grades, absences, and other issues on campus.

Materials: Comprehensive progress report for each student. You can print this from INOW.

Lesson: Teachers may want to look at comprehensive progress reports ahead of time and decide which kids need more one on one counseling. Teachers will take a few minutes with each student to discuss grades, credits, attendance and other issues they may be having on campus. For those students who may possibly fail, you may want to figure out what that student needs to make in order to pass the class for the year. Teachers also look at the discipline logs on Google Docs and see if any of your homeroom students are on there multiple times and try to help them fix the issue.

Evidence: Teachers should take notes on what was discussed and keep for evidence to be place in student's file.
