The motivation is to be destructive and post the footage online to gain "Tik Tok" notoriety. We are seeing this disturbing trend across the nation as well as in school systems around our state.

Actions of this nature will not be tolerated in Daleville City Schools. We ask that parents have a conversation with their child and reinforce the importance of not following along, participating in, or glamorizing this type of behavior. Parents need to know that if students are caught participating in these challenges, they will be disciplined, and there could be possible legal ramifications. We will not tolerate these actions and the complete disregard for student and staff safety and a clean learning environment.

Vandalism, stealing, and acts of a disorderly nature are all against the Daleville City Schools Code of Student Conduct and can also be illegal in many situations. The Daleville Board of Education will deal with any destructive or abusive behavior according to Board Policy and the Code of Conduct to the fullest extent possible.

Please talk with your student and encourage them to make wise choices. We are asking that you help us end this disturbing trend. Help your student understand that a moment of fun in the spotlight will not be worth the serious and extended consequences that will follow.
